Online Livestock Marketing Internship

We will be hiring one intern for the summer of 2025. The purpose of this internship is to provide a multi-faceted learning experience for a student interested in youth livestock activities, marketing livestock and leadership. Major responsibilities include assisting the team with various summer activities including planning for activities held at multiple junior national livestock shows. The intern will also spend time with sales representatives, industry leaders and the technology development team. The internship requires excellent written and oral communication skills as one will be expected to represent the organization on a daily basis. Individual must be a self-starter with organization skills to assist with the event planning responsibilities. The internship will be approximately mid-May through early August depending on the student's academic schedule and will be a remote based position with some travel.

Golf Shop Attendant

Registers golfers for their tee times, checks in customers, takes payment and assigns golf carts. Maintains accurate logs. Assist members/customers with merchandise questions courteously and professionally. Cash out members/customers and monitor the front counter. Stock, tag and display merchandise on golf shop floor ensuring all merchandise is neatly arranged and restocked to proper level. Maintain the cleanliness of the pro shop and assists with cleaning golf carts when necessary. Handle customer service request of members in a courteous and professional manner. Maintains neat, well groomed, professional appearance and demeanor. Adheres to club dress code always. Assists with the step up of tournament, league or other golf events. Assist with merchandise inventory when needed. Applicants should demonstrate a commitment to the work and success of the company by being solution-oriented, having positive interactions with all team members and meeting customer service standards set by management. Performs additional assignments per the direction of the club or Company managers. Must have the ability to deliver a high level of customer service. Good oral communication skills. Can compute simple math and count change accurately.

Milker / Farm Hand

We are seeking dedicated individuals to join our team to assist with the daily milking of cows. This position involves working evenings and weekends, with occasional morning shifts. Experience in milking is a plus, but we welcome individuals with a strong work ethic and a willingness to learn. Responsibilities include: perform milking duties during evening (3PM-6PM) and occasional morning (5AM-7AM) shifts, ensure proper handling and care of cows during the milking process, maintain cleanliness and hygiene in the milking area, and report any issues or concerns related to equipment, cow health, or milking procedures.

Agriculture and Environment Reporter Intern

We are seeking an intern to work closely with our agriculture and environment team. The intern's primary focus will be covering the people who are the lifeblood of making the industry successful, along with the challenges they face. That includes a broad range of stories, from human-interest features to hard-hitting investigations: ag-related fairs and expos, profiles of industry leaders and up-and-comers, water contamination, disease and food-borne pathogen outbreaks and recalls, new research and technology in farming practices, weather-related and labor industry challenges, and government and public policy regulations. This coverage also includes two of the most important issues in the state's industry today: mental and physical health challenges that farmers face and the continued fight by South Dakota farmers against eminent domain regulations as large companies try to build carbon capture pipelines across the state.

Key responsibilities include: connects with the community through storytelling and outreach (social media, on-camera interviews, forums, community leadership, etc.), provides thoughtful analysis of complex issues, collaborates to provide all appropriate elements for stories, such as photos, video and graphics, and uses social media to promote the content.
